Professor for interior architecture at Politecnico di Milano – Scuola di Design, focusing on the theoretical and methodological foundations of design in interior and spatial design. Lecturer at the Institute for Social Planning, Organisational and Urban Development at the FHNW until 2022, focusing on criteria and processes of social and sustainable urban development and the interplay of social, built, and perceived environment. From 2012 to 2019, exhibition curator at the Vitra Design Museum, responsible for the international touring exhibition *Lightopia. Designing Light, The Bauhaus #itsalldesign*, and *Balkrishna Doshi: Architecture for the people*, among others. Studies in architecture, art history and urban sociology in Florence, Mendrisio, and Paris with an MSc in architecture and several years of practical professional experience (design, client representation, project and construction management) in Switzerland, Italy, France, and Germany.
